


- Children's Online Privacy

- Brain under construction




The Teenage Brain

Decisions made on Emotion






The developing fronal lobe of a teenager. (Photo:





How to Find Secret Apps on Your Child's iPhone



On your child's phone, go to the App Store and use the search tool to look for these key words "hidden, private photos, photo vault, or secret."

If your child has any of these apps, it will say "open" next to it.



If your child does NOT have the app, it will say "get."



If your child used to have it and has deleted it, it will have a cloud icon.

Iphone ---- swipe down ---- type in the name of the app ---- eg snapchat ---- if it comes up your child has it and has hidden it.

- Search Your Childs name regularly
- Take It Down- ISP provider
- App Age Appropriate
- Common Areas
- Parental Control Programs (Parental Control Kid Tracker App)
- Become your child's online friend
- To Post or Not to Post



Tips Continued

- Check followers
- Pay attention to Privacy Settings
- Disable location settings
- Change passwords regularly
- Report bullying, fake accounts and inappropriate use of material
